7.3 ADOPT Ordinance No. ____ Regarding Accessory and Junior Accessory Dwelling Units

This lead agency has determined that the project is statutorily exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (pursuant to Section 21080.17 of the Public Resources Code) because it is an ordinance regarding second units in a single-family or multifamily residential zone to implement the provisions of Government Code Section 65852.2. and categorically exempt, Class 1, for existing facilities because it provides for the creation of junior accessory dwelling units within an existing bedroom of existing single-family residences involving negligible expansion of existing residential use and any required interior and/or exterior alterations will not increase the floor area of the residential structure.

A Draft Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration was originally prepared by the applicant's selected environmental consultant and subsequently adopted by the Pleasant Hill Recreation & Park District Board of Directors on September 9, 2010. This environmental document included a comprehensive evaluation of the Senior Center, Teen Center and Community Center projects, as well as the Pleasant Oaks Park Improvement project, and was previously accepted by the Planning Commission as adequate for those projects. This document was determined to remain adequate for consideration of the proposed accessory utility building pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Sections 15162 and 15163. The document is available for review at the Planning Division counter, City of Pleasant Hill, City Hall (100 Gregory Lane) and the Pleasant Hill Recreation and Park District at 147 Gregory Lane. In addition, pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15061 (b)(4), CEQA is not applicable to projects which are denied by the lead agency.
