
- 1. 3'-0" MAX. HEIGHT CRITERIA APPLIES TO FLAT TERRAIN AREAS. WHERE SLOPES OR OTHER IRREGULAR GRADE CONDITIONS IMPAIR SIGHT VISIBILITY, THE CITY ENGINEER MAY DETERMINE THE ALLOWABLE FENCE HEIGHT TO BE LESS THAN 3 FEET.
- 2. THE PEDESTRIAN CLEAR AREA (4 FEET 6 INCHES MINIMUM) SHALL BE CONSIDERED FROM THE BACK OF AN EXISTING CURB, FROM THE EDGE OF AN OPEN DITCH, OR FROM THE EDGE OF THE PAVED ROAD AS DETERMINED BY THE CITY ENGINEER IN THE FIELD.
- 3. ANY PERMANENT FENCE OR STRUCTURE WITHIN THE CITY'S RIGHT OF WAY REQUIRES AN ENCROACHMENT PERMIT FROM THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT. IF A PERMIT (PERPETUAL) IS GRANTED, THE CITY MAY REQUEST THE HOMEOWNER TO REMOVE THE ENCROACHMENT, AT HOMEOWNER'S EXPENSE, IF THE RIGHT OF WAY IS NEEDED BY THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT FOR A PUBLIC PROJECT.
- 4. THE PERMITTEE SHALL CALL USA (1-800-227-2600) TO LOCATE POTENTIAL UTILITIES WITHIN THE CITY'S RIGHT OF WAY PRIOR TO DIGGING:
