On Friday May 25, 2018 at approximately 11:32 am PHPD officers responded to the area of Santa Monica Dr near Sunvalley Blvd for the report of gunshots heard and a male on the ground waving for help. Officers responded to the scene and located a 27 year old male victim in the front yard of a residence, suffering from an apparent gunshot wound to his lower body. The victim was conscious when transported to a local hospital for treatment. He is in stable condition as of this writing.

A preliminary investigation suggests this shooting occurred during an intended purchase of marijuana. There is no current evidence to suggest the suspect(s) involved are local to the neighborhood where this incident occurred. It appears the scene was chosen at random and likely due to its proximity to public areas and the nearby freeway.

At this time suspect(s) have not been identified, but our investigation is ongoing. Additional details will be shared as they become available and relevant for public release.
