

**DECLARATION OF THE PLEASANT HILL DIRECTOR OF EMERGENCY SERVICES
PROCLAIMING A LOCAL EMERGENCY AND IMPOSING A CURFEW**

WHEREAS, under authority contained in California Government Code sections 8610 and 8634 and the City of Pleasant Hill Municipal Code Section 3.45.040, I have on this 1st day of June, 2020, declared the existence of a local emergency in the City of Pleasant Hill due to groups of individuals causing significant property damage and theft resulting in arrests; and

WHEREAS, I am empowered, upon proclamation of a local emergency, to make and issue regulations on matters reasonably related to the protection of life and property as affected by such emergency; and

WHEREAS, under conditions of the emergency, it is deemed necessary in the interest of public safety to restrict the use of certain public areas of the City; and

WHEREAS, life and property is deemed to be in peril and speed is of the essence.


THEREFORE, I June Catalano, as Director of Emergency Services, hereby declare that, commencing on June 1st, 2020, a curfew is in effect **starting at 7:00 p.m. and ending at 5:30 a.m.**, during which no person shall be upon the public street, avenue, alley, park, or other public place or unimproved public realty **within the commercial areas throughout the City.**

This curfew shall not apply to police officers, peace officers, firefighters, or other emergency personnel or civilians engaged in police or emergency work, nor shall it apply to authorized representatives of any news service, newspaper, or radio or television station or network, nor shall it apply to individuals seeking or providing medical care or care for family members or others, people traveling to or from their place of employment, or any persons experiencing homelessness.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the law enforcement forces of the City of Pleasant Hill, along with the law enforcement authorities cooperating with the City, are hereby authorized and charged, to the extent provided by law, with the responsibility of enforcing this curfew and are further authorized to arrest such persons as do not obey this curfew after due notice, oral or written, has been given to said citizen. Any violation of this declaration shall be punished as provided in the City of Pleasant Hill Municipal Code.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this regulation shall remain in effect until such time as it is terminated by the Director of Emergency Services or the City Council of the City of Pleasant Hill.
